

Tannya Harricks – Art Tutor



Tannya Harricks is a Sydney based artist known for her lush paintings characterised by gestural marks and painterly abstractions. Intent on capturing the energy of the subject through spontaneous gesture, she paints intuitively and without premeditation. The subject of her work is reimagined in the manipulation of colour and form with fluid brushwork.

Tannya has been a finalist in numerous Awards including recently the Paddington Art Prize (2023), Grace Cossington Smith Art Award (2024), Gallipoli Art Prize (2023), Muswellbrook Art Prize (2018) and is the recipient of the Waverley Art Prize (2013) and The Hornsby Art Prize (2012). Her work is held in private and public collections including Gold Coast City Council, Wollongong Private Hospital, Waverley and Hornsby City Councils.

Tannya has 29 years of experience as a designer, textile artist, illustrator and artist. She has illustrated 5 children's books including Dingo (winner of Premier's Literary award 2019), Kookaburra and Mallee Sky and has illustrated The Heartbeat of the Land by Cathy Freeman and most recently Night Watch.
